We continue to move out of this pandemic, although more slowly than we would like as cases crop up in schools and workplaces. A war is raging in the Ukraine, and gas prices and the cost of groceries are soaring. It has, and continues to be a challenging period in our history, to say the least. All of this is frustrating and exhausting, and I know that it is taking its toll on all of us.

At the local level of government we do not regulate the money supply or provide for defense expenditures, but we do focus on improving the quality of life in our town. That is why we recently put forth a budget plan that maintains critical services, bolsters senior and recreational programming, keeps police officers in schools to protect our kids, and keeps our financial house in order to stabilize taxes. The budget also funds a down payment on important capital projects including road repairs, updates to our Public Safety communications systems, park improvements and maintenance of our infrastructure.

I am proud to say that our 2022 budget was adopted in a bi-partisan manner, and want to recognize Council President Juned Qazi for his leadership and efforts during what was a 14 week long budget process. Our goal continues to be maintaining our status as a premier suburban community in the State of New Jersey, and one of the safest in the nation.

While we can't control what happens in the nation's capital or overseas, I am confident that with the help of our employees, volunteers and caring members of this community, we can continue to make things better for our families here in Marlboro.

To address the uptick in vehicle thefts facing suburban communities around the State, we are asking residents to go on-line and pledge to take basic steps to keep their vehicles and homes safe. In return, a Police Officer will deliver a 'We Took the Pledge' lawn sign to your home. Vehicles stolen in our town almost exclusively have been unlocked with the key fob inside.
