I am pleased to announce that we have partnered with legislative officials and our local healthcare systems to prioritize senior citizen vaccination scheduling. In order to be eligible for this priority registration you must be 65 or older and a Marlboro Township resident.

We will be collecting basic information so that our seniors will be contacted directly and scheduled for a vaccine appointment. Do not hesitate to complete the form even if you have registered elsewhere as this can help expedite the process. Note that we are unable to confirm which vaccine will be available when your appointment is scheduled.

We have been advised that individuals able to travel to the Meadowlands vaccination mega-site are more likely to receive appointments faster. However, all registrants are being prioritized and scheduled for appointments as soon as possible, even if you require a local appointment location.
