U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Reviews Cleanup at Burnt Fly Bog Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting its **Fourth** Five-Year Review of the **Burnt Fly Bog Superfund Site** located in Marlboro, Monmouth County and Old Bridge, Monmouth County, New Jersey. This review seeks to confirm that the cleanup conducted at the site continues to be protective of public health and the environment and is functioning as designed. Cleanup activities included, but were not limited to, the following: 1) Excavation and removal of hazardous materials from on-site lagoons, the Tar Patch Area and the Asphalt Pile Area; 2) Capping in the Uplands Area; 3) Construction of a sedimentation pond to prevent contaminant migration; 4) Continued groundwater, surface water and sediment monitoring to ensure the effectiveness of the remedy; and 5) Institutional and engineering controls, such as deed restrictions and fencing.

A summary of these activities and evaluation of the long-term protectiveness of the remedy will be included in the upcoming report which will be available in the spring of 2016 in the library, township municipal building or on our web page listed below.

What is an EPA Five-Year Review?

EPA inspects Superfund sites every five years to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of human health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by federal law when contaminants remain at a site, include:

- Inspection of the site and cleanup technologies;
- Review of monitoring data, operating data, and maintenance records, and
- Determination if any new regulatory requirements have been established since EPA's original cleanup decision was finalized.
