Requirements:

- 1. Install and maintain approved fire hydrants for the proposed buildings fire flow as indicated on sheet #10 of plan 01-20-2021. Annual GPM flow testing required with all reports and hydrant map submitted to the Fire Bureau. 507.2, 507.3, 507.5
- Install and maintain approved fire lanes per the Fire Bureau specifications (attachment). Maintain a minimum road width of 26 feet as indicated on sheet # 6 of plan 01-20-2021. Ensure all plantings/landscape maintain a minimum vertical height of 13 feet six inches on all roadways/fire lanes. No on-street parking. Submit a separate plan/diagram to the Fire Bureau for approval prior to marking and signage installation. 503.1, 503.2, 503.3
- Install and maintain an approved fire sprinkler system in the proposed buildings. Submit quarterly test/certification records per NFPA 25 to the Fire Bureau. 901.6.2
- Install and maintain an approved monitored fire and carbon monoxide alarm system in the proposed buildings. Submit annual test/certification records on NFPA 72 forms to the Fire Bureau. 907.8
- Install and maintain an approved rapid entry system (Knox Box) and a master key and/or access card/fob for all secured locations in the proposed buildings. Twp. Ord. 183-36
- Install and maintain an approved emergency services radio repeater system in accordance with Marlboro Police Communications in the proposed buildings. Annual testing/certification required, submit all reports to the Fire Bureau. 510.1, 510.6
- 7. Install mountable curbs at the entrance roads/islands at Texas Road and at all intersections throughout the proposed site.
- 8. Ensure the proposed road/street names are not duplicated or similar to any of the current road/street names within the Township.
- 9. Install and maintain a community directory sign including a map with the address numbers overlaid on the proposed buildings at each entrance. Submit a map in electronic form to the Fire Districts and the Fire Bureau.
- 10. Install and maintain approved building number signs a minimum of 24 inches high and 24 inches wide, visible from all the proposed roads.



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- 11. Install and maintain approved address numbers a minimum of four inches high, reflective, and visible from both directions of all proposed roads. 505.1
- 12. Install and maintain approved truss construction emblems. 2.20
- 13. All open flame-cooking devices (grills) shall be operated and stored a minimum of 10 feet from any building or structure. 308.1.4, 308.1.4.4
- Create and maintain an approved clothes dryer and exhaust vent cleaning schedule for all the proposed buildings. Submit the cleaning reports to the Fire Bureau. 603.6
- 15. Install and maintain approved signs for all sprinkler, fire alarm, and equipment rooms/mechanical rooms, minimum one-inch high characters. 509.1
- 16. Install and maintain all fire department connections and approved signs on the front side of the proposed buildings. 912.1
- 17. Locate all trash enclosures, trash receptacles, and recycling enclosures a minimum of 15 feet from the proposed buildings and property lines. 315.4
- 18. Install and maintain approved fire extinguishers at each common area exit door and floor landing. Submit all inspection reports to the Fire Bureau. 906.1, 906.2

Recommendations:

- 1. Install and maintain an approved fire-fighting standpipe system in the proposed buildings per NFPA 25. Submit all inspection reports to the Fire Bureau. 905.1
- 2. No combustible mulch or landscaping within three feet of the proposed buildings.

Submit any updates to the plan for an additional review.
