

ROAD CONSTRUCTION NOTICE – Week of September 23, 2019

**** The Department of Public Works (DPW) **EMERGENCY STORM DEBRIS REMOVAL (BRUSH ONLY)** is COMPLETE. No further lawn debris may be curbside until the regularly scheduled collection to begin late October by zone as per the recycling calendar [HERE](#).

SUBJECT TO ROAD CLOSURES – POLICE PRESENT

ROAD CLOSURE - Texas Road entrance to American Plaza (Costco Shopping Center) will be CLOSED on **Wednesday, September 25 and/or Thursday, September 26** (weather and schedule dependent) from 7am to 7pm. All traffic into and out of the shopping center will be directed through the Route 9 entrance. Detours will be in place and Marlboro Police will be on site. Please expect delays, leave extra time and plan accordingly.

Pleasant Valley Road – Construction will begin Wednesday with the installation of mountable concrete curb between Conover Road and Mockingbird Lane. This project is a part of a FEMA Grant awarded August 13, 2019. The work is expected to take approximately 4 months to complete.

ROADS TO REMAIN OPEN – CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY – POLICE PRESENT

The roads will remain open and accessible during construction, although motorists are advised to use caution through the work zone.

Ingersoll Road, Edit Drive, Jean Court, Annette Drive, Ike Court – Concrete work (curb ramp reconstruction, spot curb replacement and inlet reconstruction) to take place Monday through Wednesday. Re-surfacing to follow at a later date.

Marlboro Summit (Regal Drive, Bond Drive, Jensen Court, Crescent Court) – Concrete work (curb ramp reconstruction, spot curb replacement and inlet reconstruction) to take place Wednesday through Friday. Re-surfacing to follow at a later date.

Monroe Drive, Jackson Way, Hoover Court, Ciafardini Court - Paving resurfacing (milling/paving) Monday through Wednesday. Striping to follow at a later date.

York Road, Ingersoll Road, Ardmore Road - Pavement resurfacing (i.e. milling/paving) Wednesday through Friday. Striping to follow at a later date.

Steeplechase Drive, Church Road, Floyd Wycoff Road, and Ruby Drive – Striping to take place Monday.

WMUA Sewer Project – The nighttime construction has concluded and they have returned to daytime construction. No road closures are expected. If possible, we suggest that you avoid the area. Final paving on Brandon Road will be scheduled at a later date.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION PREVIEW (MAIN THOROUGHFARES)

Harbor Road – Reconstruction to take place at the intersection of Route 79. (Wooleytown Road, Amboy Road and Texas Road – Paving and striping completed as of Monday afternoon.)

ROUTE 520 AND TENNENT ROAD INTERSECTION – The installation of the ADA required curb ramps is complete. State contractors will return to complete striping and signage in advance of the left-turn signal becoming operational. Please see prior Road Construction Notice [HERE](#) for more.

Union Hill Road –The roadway was paved in the vicinity of the commuter lot as well as repairs within the lot completed. Additional paving in the area will be scheduled at night during the coming weeks.

Peasley Drive –HUD grant received in the amount of \$120,370 for the resurfacing of Peasley Drive.
