LEGISLATIVE MINUTES

MARLBORO TOWNSHIP COUNCIL MEETING

January 16, 2020

The Marlboro Township Council held its regularly scheduled meeting on January 16, 2020 at 7:00 P.M. at the Marlboro Municipal Complex, 1979 Township Drive, Marlboro, New Jersey.

Council President Mazzola opened the meeting and announced that pursuant to the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act, notice of this regularly scheduled meeting of the Township Council of the Township of Marlboro was sent to the Asbury Park Press, the Star Ledger, News Transcript and Board of Education Office on January 7, 2020; published in the Asbury Park Press on January 9, 2020; posted on the Bulletin Board of the Municipal Building; filed in the office of the Municipal Clerk and placed on the township website and Channel 77.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE OPEN SPACE DEDICATION OF BLOCK 154 LOT 17.06 LOCATED ON REIDS HILL ROAD ON THE OFFICIAL TAX MAP OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MARLBORO

WHEREAS, Carl G. Antisell, Douglas A. Antisell and Donald T. Antisell received Zoning Board approval for a subdivision on April 26, 2016 which proposed dedication of Block 154 Lot 17.06, comprising approximately 14 acres located on REIDS HILL ROAD on the official tax map of the Township of Marlboro for conservation purposes as part of the grant of subdivision approval; and

WHEREAS, it is a matter of procedure that the Township of Marlboro adopt an Ordinance accepting the dedication of this Block and Lot.

WHEREAS, the Monmouth County Cooperative Purchasing Program conducted a public bidding process and awarded contracts to various vendors for the provision of AUTO, TRUCK, HEAVY EQUIPMENT AND LAWN MOWER PARTS AND SUPPLIES; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has indicated that the various vendors listed below have agreed to extend the pricing provided to Monmouth and Somerset County to Marlboro Township through the Monmouth and Somerset County Cooperative Purchasing Program; and
