Revised plans to include larger parking spots next to vacuums, additional stop signs and stop bars, cut back islands to enhance turn ability, and 9 vacuum stations.

located at Tennent Road, Block 122, Lot 33, within the C2
Zone. Mr. Cramer and Ms. Cofone appeared on behalf of the
applicants and was sworn in. Mr. Cramer testified on the revised
site plan rendering, exhibit A-43 dated 7-2-20. They will comply
with all items in the Engineers report in regard to stormwater
management. Township Engineer agreed that it is compliant
